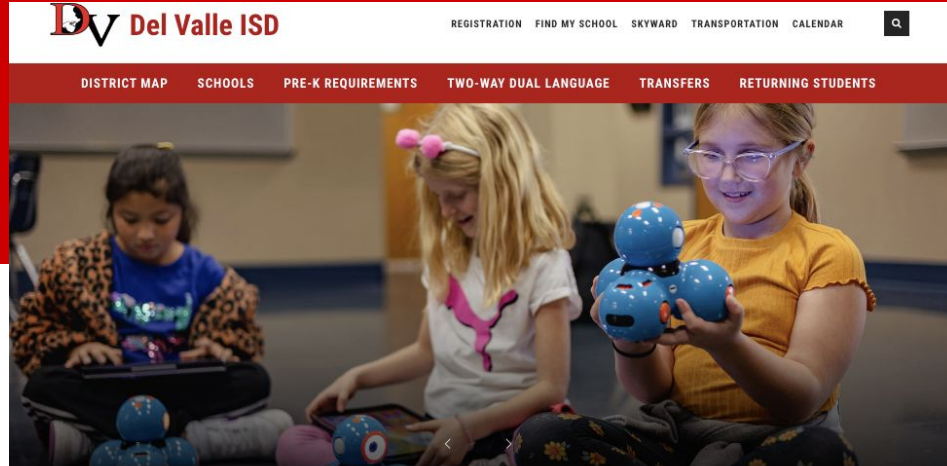

2019 Bond Update

2019 Bond Development and Voter Approval



- Architect selection committee selected O'Connell Robertson to support the bond development process in Fall of 2018
- Citizen Growth Committee met and developed the bond ballot measure
- Members of the Citizens Growth Committee provided a recommendation to the DVISD Board of Trustees in Summer 2019
- DVISD Board of Trustees adjusted and then approved the bond ballot measure Summer 2019
- DVISD Board of Trustees called for the Bond Election for November 2019
- Voters in Del Valle ISD overwhelmingly approved the 284 million dollar bond

2019 Bond Budget Milestones



- November 2019 Voters approved a comprehensive bond for 284 million dollars
- Spring 2020 Del Valle ISD evaluated project schedules and began facility improvements
- Summer 2020 Del Valle ISD developed a strategy to accelerate projects and mitigate inflation
- Throughout 2021 and 2022 Del Valle ISD reached agreements with contractors, architects, professional service groups and suppliers to secure pricing during construction
- Fall 2022 Del Valle ISD had engaged design firms for all projects from the 2019 bond commitments
- Spring 2023 Del Valle ISD secured the final new facility project Guaranteed Maximum Price for the Early College High School / P Tech Center
- **Summer 2023 Del Valle ISD will have 6 million dollars remaining for additional district improvements after fulfilling all commitments from the 2019 bond**

- Facility and athletic improvements for student programs
- Construction of a central operations, maintenance and warehouse facility
- Campus renovations and enhancements to furniture
- Land purchase for future development

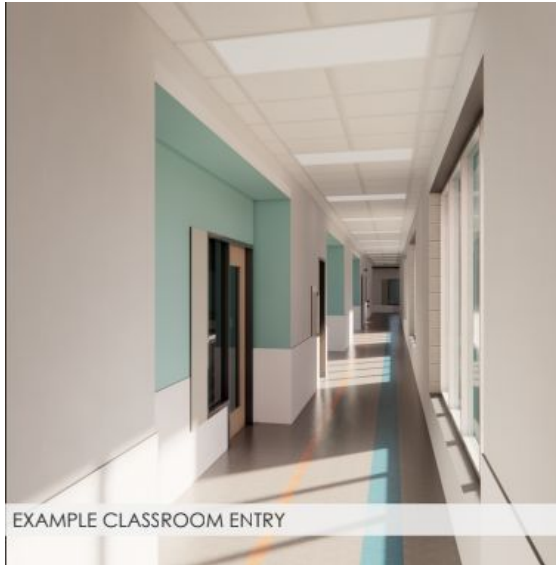

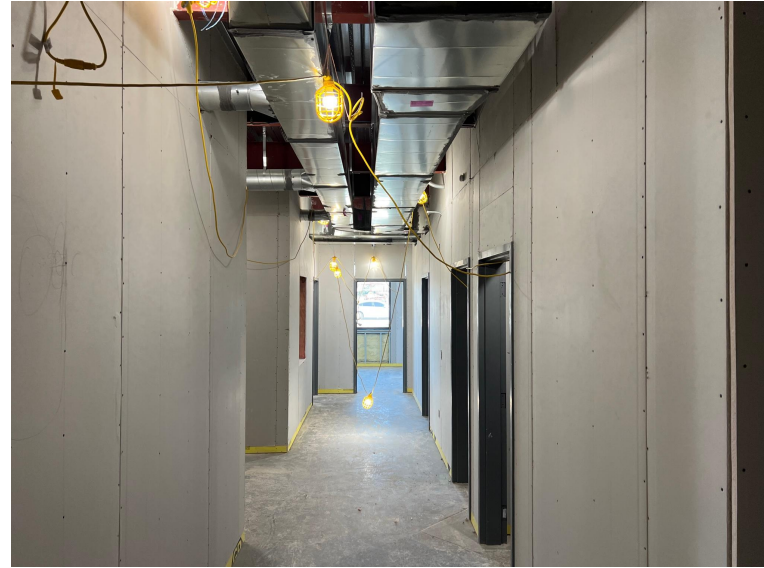

- 2025 - Pending Fleet Review



2019 Bond - Completed Technology Improvements



- Off-site disaster recovery site, infrastructure, and backup hardware.
- Shared server storage used to host district systems.
- Replacement of poor quality and failing cafeteria sound systems.
- Provide teachers with laptops for remote and hybrid learning.
- Elementary and middle school 1-to-1 devices expansion
- Provide SWIVL cameras for all core classroom teachers for remote and hybrid learning.
- Provide SWIVL cameras for all core classroom teachers for remote and hybrid learning.
- Auxiliary campus technology for learning. Calculators and some headphones have been ordered and distributed. Currently collecting needs for classroom headphones.
- Replace all 1GB fiber runs at each campus with 10GB fiber.

2019 Bond - Ongoing Technology Improvements



- Deploy handheld campus radios and construct a towers for districtwide communication.
- Provide iPads and Chromebooks for use in special education classrooms.
- Upgrade, tune, and optimize district wireless and switching.
- Replace end-of-life handsets and purchase call manager support.
- Replace end-of-life projectors throughout district with an interactive solution.
- Providing wireless hotspots for student connectivity.
- Upgrade district security camera platform and replace old and end-of-life cameras.
- True North Technology, Connectivity, and Cybersecurity assessments.
- Replace Laptop Batteries and end-of-life devices.
- CTE Devices

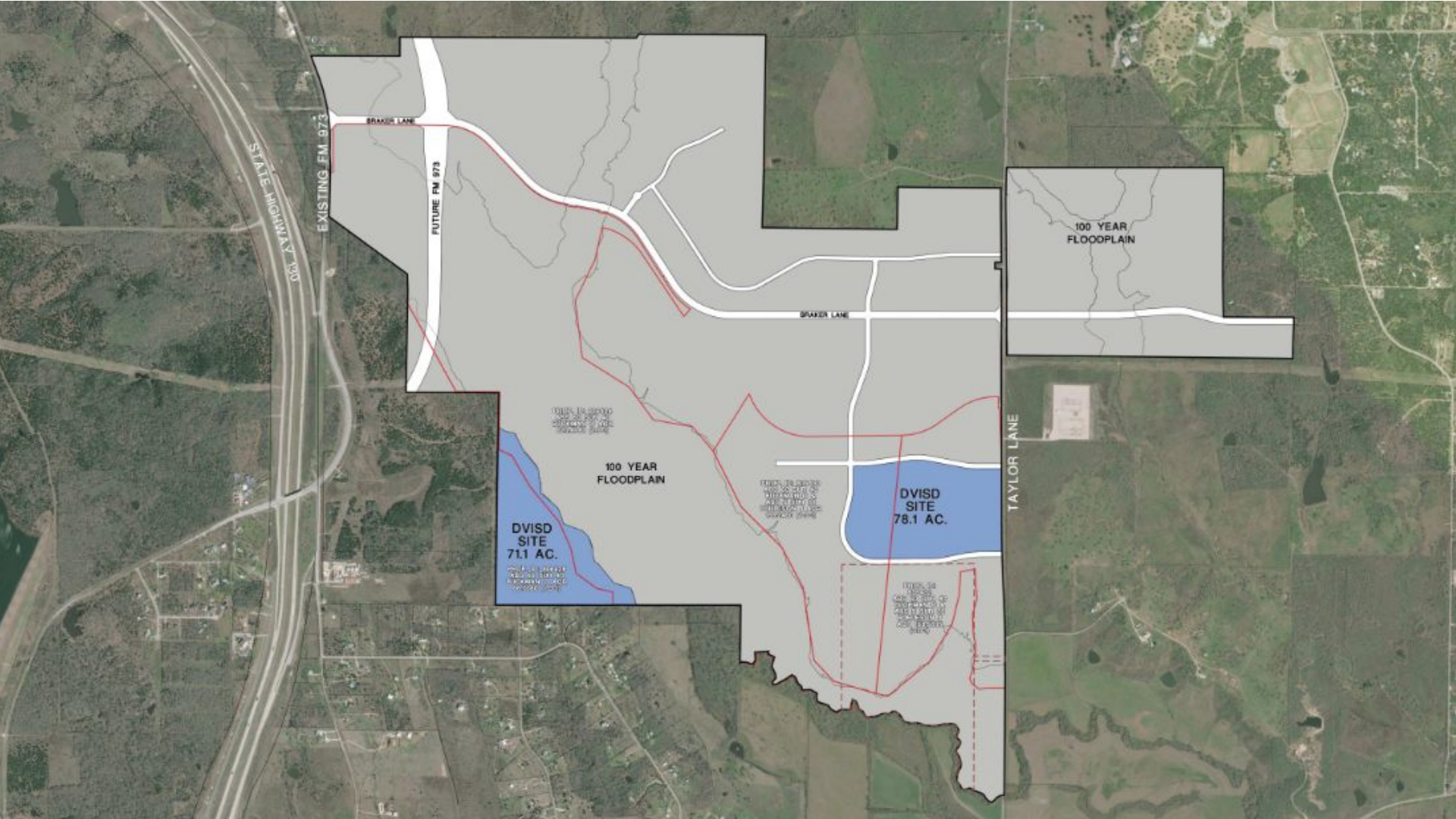
- All demo and rebuild campuses will be open by Fall 2023

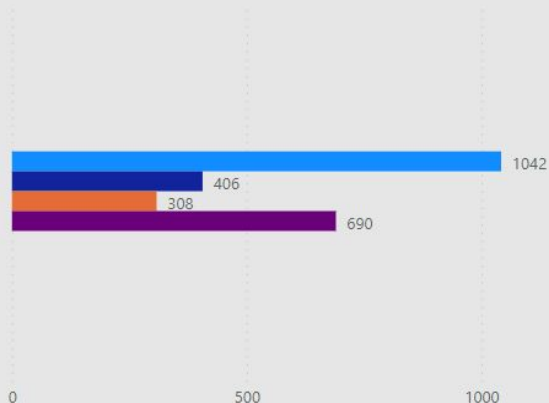

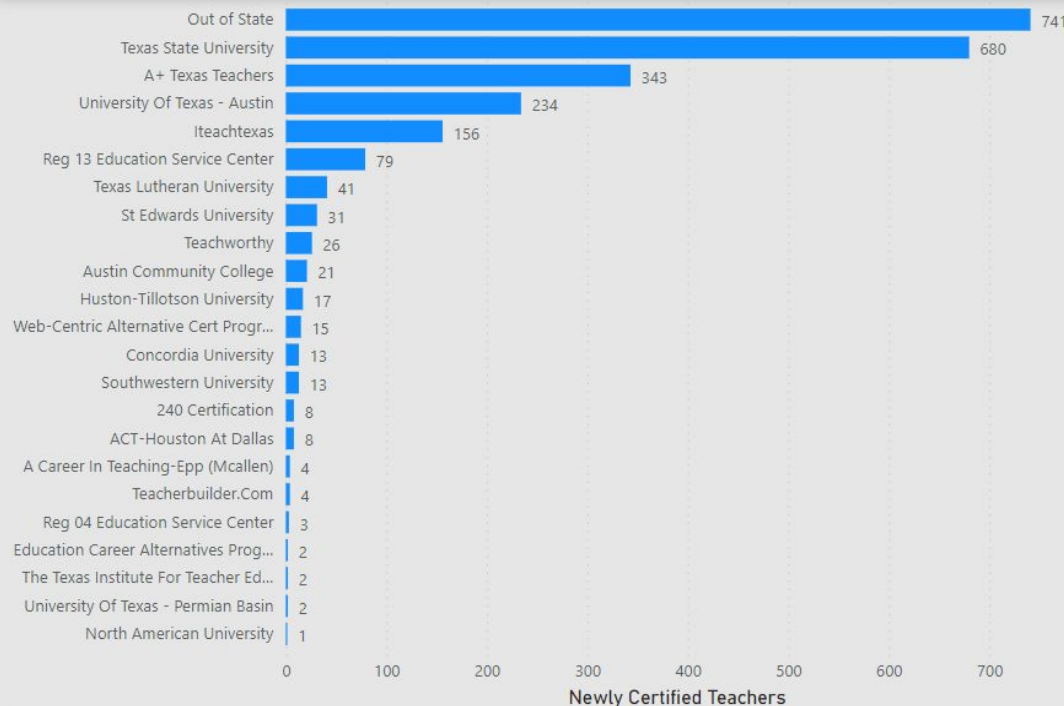

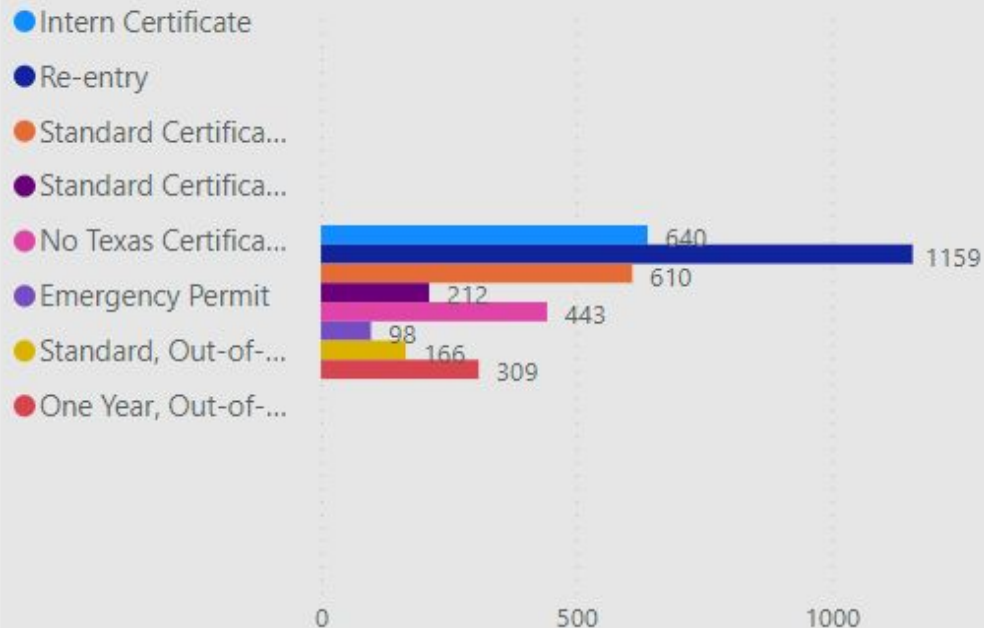
